Indication

JUBLIA® (efinaconazole) topical solution, 10%, is a prescription medicine used to treat fungal infections of the toenails.

Important Safety Information

 JUBLIA is for use on nails and surrounding skin only. Do not use JUBLIA in your mouth, eyes, or vagina. Use it exactly as instructed by your doctor.

If you've got toenail fungus, you're not alone

Onychomycosis (on-ick-oh-my-CO-sis), a condition that may involve the toenails or fingernails, is relatively common. It may affect as many as 35 million people in the US — and toenail infections are particularly common. JUBLIA is indicated for the treatment of fungal infections of the toenails only.

What is toenail fungus?

Toenail fungus is an infection that lives underneath the nail, in the skin of the nail bed. Toenail fungus is more than a cosmetic concern. Recurrence is common.

Symptoms of toenail fungus may include:

- Thickening of the nail
- Discoloration
- Change in nail shape
- Loosening/lifting of nail
- Rrittleness
- · Crumbling of nail edges

Important Safety Information (Cont'd)

- It is not known whether JUBLIA is safe and effective for use in children under 6 years of age.
- Before you or your child uses JUBLIA, tell your doctor about all medical conditions, including if you are pregnant, are breast feeding, or plan to breastfeed, because it is not known whether JUBLIA can harm an unborn fetus or nursing infant.

Contributing factors

Factors that may increase the risk of developing toenail fungus include:

- Wearing closed-toe shoes
- Getting pedicures with improperly sanitized tools
- Having a chronic illness, such as diabetes or HIV
- Having a deformed nail or a nail disease

Overall results from 2 clinical studies:

17% of patients had completely clear nails

Complete Cure: No fungus present and 0% visible toenail impairment

Important Safety Information (Cont'd)

- Tell your doctor about all medications you or your child is taking, and whether you or your child has any other nail infections.
- JUBLIA is flammable. Avoid heat and flame while applying JUBLIA to the toenail.

In 2 separate clinical studies

JUBLIA was applied daily for 48 weeks — working to treat the fungus to allow a clearer nail to grow back. Results were measured after completing treatment with JUBLIA at 52 weeks.

Individual results from 2 clinical studies:

- 18% of patients in Study 1 and 15% in Study 2 had completely clear nails
- 26% of patients in Study 1 and 23% in Study 2 had clear or almost clear nails
- 55% of patients in Study 1 and 53% in Study 2 tested fungus-free

Using JUBLIA

JUBLIA is specifically formulated to reach the site of infection to treat toenail fungus.



Side effects

- JUBLIA may cause irritation at the treated site.
- Low incidence of side effects: The most common side effects (around 2% of patients) in clinical trials were ingrown toenail, redness, itching, swelling, burning or stinging, blisters, and pain.
- No known drug interactions.

Tell your doctor about any side effects that bother you or do not go away.

Sticking with treatment

JUBLIA should be applied **once daily for 48 weeks**, exactly as directed by your doctor. It may
be useful for you to establish a routine to help
you stick to your treatment.

- Apply JUBLIA to the affected toenails 1 time each day and at the same time and place (i.e., in the morning or before bed)
- Combine using JUBLIA with other daily activities
- Set a reminder on your phone or watch
- When traveling, keep JUBLIA in a convenient place
